

Eco-Policy

1. To include environmental concerns and green spirituality in our liturgy and teaching - eg in sermons, hymns, prayers; children's activities; 2nd Sunday Forums
2. To include our carbon-footprint and environmentally friendly products in our decisions - eg on heating, electricity, resource management, and to look at the feasibility of this in our financial management.
3. To support local and global environmental action, - eg developing our Quiet Garden, supporting local groups (the Council, TLC, Westport garden), our charitable giving, Fairtrade, Christian Aid, Days for Girls.
4. To encourage members personal efforts to be green, - eg promoting well-being from recreational walking and cycling, car-sharing, public transport options, in talks, magazine etc
5. To communicate more widely on green issues via our website and social media

6. To review the policy and action plan annually.
